We are pleased to announce the commencement of the Horizon Europe project, PEERS, which **TFC Research and Innovation Limited**, prepared in collaboration with the Project Coordinator, **KPMG-FA, Resilience Advisors Network** as well as fellow consortium members. The proposal undertaken was performed by members of the new European proposal development department at TFC Research and Innovation Limited. Project **PEERS** aims to advance and **reinforce existing policy** through **practitioner-driven** pre-normative standardisation processes, which will enhance the development of a European **Better Practice Guide** initiative. The project will support the effective **strengthening of preparedness** and **response** in the field of **disaster risk resilience** and **CBRN** through the Better Practice Guide initiative, which was instigated in the **NO-FEAR** project on standardisation. The PEERS ecosystem brings together Europe's disaster risk management for **natural hazards** and **CBRN** and European research policy-making and practitioner stakeholders as well as standardisation bodies with a view to strengthen European resilience to hazards situations through the application of a comprehensive **engagement** and **consultation** mechanism. It takes advantage of existing platforms in Copernicus, such as the European Forest Fire Information System (EFFIS) and the air quality monitor system (CAMS) to help strengthen the PEERS ecosystem capability for additional resilience to environmental factors. The ecosystem also includes the incorporation of a **gamification strategy** aimed at attracting more users, increasing interactions in the platforms and further develop training skills based on **situation awareness**.

PEERS commenced on November 1st, 2022, bringing together an experienced, multi-disciplinary team of experts, who collectively as a consortium, will work together as a focused delivery team on meeting policy maker and practitioners needs for the next 36 months.
